### PSB College plans to construct new facility

**HCMC – HCMC-based Cetana PSB Intellis School on Monday announced to build a new campus in Long Thoi, Nha Be District with the new trade name PSB College Vietnam after joining forces with PSB Academy in Singapore.**



Vinodh Coomaraswamy, general director of PSB College Vietnam, said on Monday that PSB College Vietnam and PSB Academy would bring an international study environment to Vietnamese students.



With the cooperation of PSB Academy Singapore, Vietnamese students will have the chance to study at PSB College as freshmen then move to PSB Academy Singapore to continue their studies.



“It will help Vietnamese students save time and money when they want to follow an international learning program,” Coomaraswamy said.

He said that PSB College planned to develop a six-hectare facility in Long Thoi of Nha Be District and diversify teaching programs within the next five years.
